OUR PROGRAMMES

NUCASTLE allows our Foundation to deliver free participant programmes, including:

- Disability Football 528 sessions
- Holiday Activity and Food provision free school meals
- After School Clubs 540 opportunities
- Walking Football

 Headways
- Premier League Kicks football for 8 18 year olds
- Employability 5,000 NU Futures by July
- Education/Classroom Activities 880 hours delivered
- Esports Qualifications and Community Academy
- Warm Rooms used by 45 families since December
- Community Fun Days average of 253 attendances
- NUCASTLE Community Pantry opening 2023



WARM ROOMS

In December, NUCASTLE opened its doors to provide a free warm space for families who need support in our community.

- 263 individuals accessed this space
- 198 were under 18
- 65 were adults
- 45 families accessed this space or support
- 177 visits from NE4 postcodes
- 62 visits from NE5 and NE6 postcodes
- 24 visits from other postcodes
- 60 hygiene packs and 6,516 sanitary products distributed





SCHOOLS

More than 880 hours of educational activities have been delivered at NUCASTLE.

Lessons include:

- STEM learning
- Esports
- Careers and Employment
- Restart a Heart (CPR education)
- 1,595 students have attended a STEM session
- 150 hours of STEM delivery
- 41 schools have attended a STEM session




DISABILITY FOOTBALL


- 528 Disability Football sessions have been delivered at NUCASTLE within the past 11 months
- 72% of participants strongly agree that they have improved their physical wellbeing as a result of these sessions
- 100% of participants have increased their fun and enjoyment levels
- Sessions at NUCASTLE have enabled 80% of participants to gain a sense of belonging
- 100% of participants have improved their mental wellbeing

98% of participants find their sessions fun


