

## Travel information from Nexus ahead of West Ham (H) Saturday 30th March

Between Friday 29th March and Monday 1st April, there are major line closures planned on the Tyne and Wear Metro, affecting travel to SJP on Saturday.

**Plan ahead and leave extra time for your journey.** Metros and bus replacement services will be busy.

## Alternative travel options

- Park & Ride with parking for £1.20 is available at Four Lane Ends and Northumberland Park for travel to St James' via Whitley Bay. The Pop app shows live parking space information.
- Park & Ride with parking for £1.20 is available at Regent Centre with frequent Arriva bus services direct to Haymarket. The Pop app shows live parking space information.
- Soccer Bus X50 is available from MetroCentre coach park with free parking and travels direct to/from Barrack Road. The first bus leaves the MetroCentre (coach park) two hours before each match. Buses then run at frequent intervals until the last departure 15 minutes before the scheduled kick-off time. Buses return from St James' Park at frequent intervals after each match. The last bus leaves one hour after the final whistle.
- Passengers from South Shields have option of traveling via Shields Ferry to North Shields and then Metro to St James' if they don't wish to use bus replacement.
